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On September 4, 2014, Delmarva filed documents (the “Filing”) with the Commission regarding the upcoming Delmarva 2015 Standard Offer Service (“SOS”) procurement cycle. This Filing contains documents with Delmarva’s proposed changes to the SOS procurement process and includes five exhibits. Exhibit 1 has the 2015 SOS Procurement Improvement Process proposals. Exhibit 2 is the redlined “Request for Proposals for Full Requirements Wholesale Electric Power Supply in Delaware” (“RFP”). Exhibit 3 is the clean version of the RFP. Exhibit 4 is the redlined version of the “Proposed Full Requirements Service Agreement (“FSA”). Exhibit 5 is the clean version of the FSA.

Delmarva’s first proposal modifies the form of its RFP to include the details for the bidding schedule for the upcoming procurement year, and its second proposal notifies the Commission of the pending implementation of PJM’s online Billing Line Item (“BLI”) application to replace the Declaration of Authority (DOA). The effective date for implementation of the BLI is not yet determined. Therefore, the DOA will remain as Exhibit I of the FRSA for this procurement cycle.

Staff reviewed the Filing with the proposed revisions as described above and found no issues related to the proposed revisions to the FSA and the RFP.
