On March 22, 2011, Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva") filed an Application with the Commission requesting approval of a proposed Dynamic Pricing Rider DP and Delmarva's currently proposed phase-in timeline for implementing dynamic pricing for all Delmarva customers served under SOS rates. The deadline for submission of petitions for intervention was on or before 4:00 p.m. EDST on Tuesday, May 3, 2011. Only those persons or entities that have been granted intervention in this matter will be permitted to present witnesses, conduct cross-examination or introduce evidence in this proceeding and at the evidentiary hearing. *Members of the public are welcome to attend the evidentiary hearings as observers.*

The Hearing Examiner will consider the Application, the pre-filed and live testimony of the parties and any other pertinent documents submitted by the parties, including any settlement that might be reached by the parties.
