ORDER NO. 6599

This 5th day of April, 2005, the Commission determines and Orders the following:

1. The Commission opened this matter by PSC Order No 6405 (May 4, 2004) as a vehicle to hear the complaints of MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. ("MCI") and its subsidiary that Verizon Delaware Inc. ("VZ-DE") had impermissibly refused their requests to "opt-into" certain provisions of other approved interconnection agreements. See 47 U.S.C. § 252(i); See also 47 C.F.R. § 51.809 (2003) (subsequently amended).

2. After proceedings before the Hearing Examiner, both the MCI carriers as well as VZ-DE have now indicated that this matter may be dismissed, with the complaints withdrawn, and with no need for further action by the Commission.

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That, based on the correspondence from MCI Communications, Inc., dated February 25, 2005, and the correspondence from Verizon

Delaware Inc., dated March 1, 2005, this proceeding is now terminated and this docket is hereby closed.

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
