**ORDER NO. 6674**

This 5th day of July, 2005, the Commission determines and Orders the following:

1. "The Electric Utility Restructuring Act of 1999" ("the Act") set about to restructure the electricity supply industry in the State of Delaware. Pursuant to the directive in 26 Del. C. § 1014(c) (as added by the Act), the Commission in 1999 established a working group to implement a consumer education program to assist Delaware's citizens as the regime moved to retail competition for supply backstopped with a default "Standard Offer Supply." PSC Order No. 5063 (April 27, 1999). See also PSC Order No. 5406 (April 11, 2000) (outlining the group's disbursement authority and responsibilities). Originally known as the "Consumer Education Working Group," the group's title later became the "Electric Choice Education Group." PSC Order No. 5178 (July 27, 1999).

2. The working group (speaking through its Chair) has now asked that the Commission formally change its title to the "Consumer Energy Education Group." The group contends that such new title is

more reflective of the group's present focus. No reason has been identified to reject such request.

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That the working group initially created by PSC Order No. 5063 (April 27, 1999) is hereby redesignated, and will hereafter operate under the title of the "Consumer Energy Education Group."

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
