AND NOW, to-wit, this 9th day of August, 2005;

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2005, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("ICG "), filed an application seeking authority to abandon service within the State of Delaware; and

WHEREAS, ICG was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") pursuant to Rule 7 of the PSC "Rules for the Provision of Telecommunications Services," to provide competitive intrastate telecommunications services by PSC Order No. 4902 in PSC Docket No. 98-242 (Sept. 29, 1998) and to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services by PSC Order No. 6194 in PSC Docket No. 02-422 (June 17, 2003); and

WHEREAS, 26 Del. C. § 203A(c)(1) provides that no public utility shall abandon or discontinue, in whole or in part, any business, operations, or services provided under a CPCN or otherwise, which are subject to jurisdiction of the Commission without first having received Commission approval for such abandonment or discontinuance; and

WHEREAS, ICG filed with the Commission a verified application seeking the entry of an Order of the Commission canceling and terminating its CPCNs; and
