AND NOW, this 10th day of January, 2006, the Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("DEC"), having, on December 12, 2005, filed with the Commission a letter application to revise its P.S.C. DEL. No. 6 Electric Tariff to include an additional street light offering with an accompanying "bundled" rate for such offering;

AND, the Commission having determined that the proposed offering and attendant rate should not go into effect until after notice and a public hearing before the full Commission; now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That, pursuant to 26 Del. C. § 306(a)(1), the proposed street light offering and attendant rate set forth in the letter application filed by the Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc., is hereby suspended pending a final determination and Order of the Commission. The Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc., shall not put such offering or rate into effect except upon further Order of the Commission or under the authority of 26 Del. C. § 306(b), (c).

2. That the Commission shall conduct a public hearing concerning the justness and reasonableness of the proposed offerings and rates before the Commission beginning at 1:00 P.M. on Tuesday, February 7, 2006.

3. That, pursuant to and in satisfaction of the requirements of 26 Del. C. §§ 304 and 305, the Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc., shall give public notice of its application and proposed offering and of the above-scheduled hearing by causing the publication of the notice hereto attached as Exhibit "A" in The News Journal and Delaware State News newspapers in two column format outlined in black on January 13, 2006, with proof of such publication to be filed with the Commission as soon thereafter as is reasonably practicable but prior to February 7, 2006.

4. That the costs of this proceeding shall be charged to the applicants in the manner prescribed by 26 Del. C. § 114.

5. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Order or Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.

On December 12, 2005, the Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("DEC"), filed with the Public Service Commission ("the Commission") a letter application to revise DEC's P.S.C. DEL. No. 6 Electric Tariff to add a new street lighting offering. This proposed offering and attendant rate are set out below. On January 10, 2006, the Commission determined that the proposed offering and rate should not go into effect until the Commission conducts a public hearing concerning the justness and reasonableness of the proposed rate.

The proposed additional street lighting offering and bundled rate are as follows:

Granville Lunar Optics 12'	\$24.58

The Commission will make its decision in this matter on the basis of the evidence of record taken at a public evidentiary hearing to be held on **February 7, 2006**, beginning at 1:00 PM. The hearing will take place at the Commission's office, located at 861 Silver Lake Boulevard, Cannon Building, Suite 100, Dover, Delaware 19904. Copies of DEC's letter application are available for public inspection at the Commission's office during normal business hours.

Members of the public may make comments regarding the application at the evidentiary hearing. Members of the public may also submit written comments. Such comments should be sent to the Commission at the above address. Interested persons may also intervene as parties by filing a petition to intervene under Rule 21 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Motions to intervene and any written comments must be filed with the Commission on or before February 3, 2006.
