**ORDER NO. 6822**

This 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2006, the Commission determines and Orders the following:

1. By prior Orders, the Commission has approved the rates and proposed tariffs for the following "grandfathered" public wastewater utilities that were in operation in July, 2004:

2. Those utilities have now filed formal Tariffs with the Commission. <sup>1</sup>The Commission here finally approves each utility's Tariff. Such Tariff shall govern that utility's operations, terms and conditions of service, and rates. Such Tariff shall not be changed except as permitted by law or by further Commission Order. The utility shall make such Tariff available to public inspection and review.<sup>2</sup>

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That the final Tariffs filed by each of the utilities listed in paragraph 1 of the body of this Order are hereby approved. Each utility shall maintain a copy of its Tariff available to the public at its principal place of business.

<sup>2</sup> The proposed final tariffs do not reflect an "issue" or "effective" date. Each utility shall promptly file a "clean" copy of its tariff reflecting an issue and effective date of "January 24, 2006."

2. That the approved Tariff shall govern the relevant utility's terms, conditions, rates, and manner of service until otherwise lawfully modified or changed.

3. The Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such other or further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
