ORDER NO. 7071

AND NOW, to-wit, this 21st day of November, 2006, the Commission ("PSC" or the "Commission") makes the following determination and Order:

1. In PSC Order No. 6417 (May 18, 2004), the Commission granted Computer Network Technology Corporation ("CNT") a conditional Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to allow it to provide local exchange and other intrastate telecommunications services within Delaware. Ordering Paragraph No. 3 (b) conditioned such CPCN on CNT having a Commission approved interconnection agreement between Computer Network Technology Corporation and Verizon Delaware Inc., or another certificated local exchange carrier.

2. In a letter filed November 1, 2006, CNT informed the Commission that in lieu of the interconnection agreement, it currently has confidential nationwide commercial contracts with multiple registered service providers including Verizon Business Solutions, MCI Worldcom, Sprint, Global Crossing, and Level 3. Under these contracts, CNT procures high-speed data circuit connectivity with CNT then, in turn, offers managed data storage connectivity solutions for non-consumer businesses and governmental entities. CNT does not offer or provide stand-alone voice-grade telecommunications services. The Commission

determines that in light of the services currently being provided by CNT, such nationwide commercial agreements should be deemed to satisfy Ordering paragraph 3(b) of PSC Order No. 6417.

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That, Computer Network Technology Corporation may substitute its commercial contracts with multiple registered service providers to satisfy the condition of Ordering paragraph no. 3 (b) in PSC Order No. 6417 (May 18, 2004) related to an interconnection agreement and that such commercial contracts shall be deemed to satisfy that condition. This determination shall continue only as long as Computer Network Technology Corporation continues the "business model" described in its letter filed November 1, 2006, and does not provide voice-grade telecommunications services within this State.

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this proceeding as may be deemed necessary or proper.
