ORDER NO. 7386

AND NOW, this 6th day of May, 2008;

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2008, Intrado Communications Inc. ("Intrado") filed with the Commission a Petition for Arbitration under Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act") regarding unresolved issues in its negotiations for an Interconnection Agreement with Verizon Delaware LLC ("Verizon DE"); and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2008, the PSC Executive Director appointed Gary A. Myers, Esquire as Arbitrator in this matter in accordance with paragraph 15 of the Commission's *Guidelines for Negotiations, Mediation, Arbitration, and Approval of Agreements Between Local Exchange Telecommunications Carriers*; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2008, Verizon DE filed a Motion to Hold in Abeyance Intrado's Petition pending a decision by the Federal Communications Commission relating to Intrado's ability to file for arbitration under Section 252 of the Act and, in addition, so that the parties will have sufficient time to negotiate the disputed issues; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated April 8, 2008, Verizon DE advised Commission Staff that the parties had agreed to stay the arbitration for 60 days to allow for further negotiations;

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. That, for the reasons set forth above, the Commission grants the request filed by Verizon Delaware LLC and Intrado Communications Inc. for a 60-day stay of the March 5, 2008 Petition for Arbitration.

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
