**ORDER NO. 7427**

**GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
TO PROVIDE PUBLIC WATER UTILITY SERVICES**

This 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2008, the Commission finds, determines, and Orders the following:

1. On May 28, 2008, Tidewater Utilities, Inc. ("Tidewater" or "Applicant") filed an application ("Application") with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to expand its facilities and operations in order to provide water services to two parcels of land located north of Slaughter Beach, one parcel of land located south of Ellendale, six parcels of land distributed west of Georgetown to south of Milton, two parcels of land located west of Bridgeville, and two parcels of land located north of Laurel, Sussex County, Delaware ("Proposed Service Area"). The basis for the Application is Tidewater's possession of a petition requesting water services signed by the owners of the parcels of land comprising the Proposed Service Area in accordance with 26 Del. C. § 203C(e)(1)b. With its Application, Tidewater filed evidence that it had mailed to the landowners in the Proposed Service Area notice of its application and the options available to affected landowners. In addition, on

Staff's direction, Tidewater published notice of its Application in two newspapers of general circulation. No comments regarding the Applicant or this Application have been received.

2. The Commission Staff has completed its review and investigation of the Application and the Applicant. In an August 12, 2008 Memorandum to the Commission, Staff reports that Tidewater's Application meets all requirements for the granting of a CPCN under 26 Del. C. § 203C and the Commission's *Regulations Governing Water Utilities Including the Public Service Commission's Jurisdiction to Grant and Revoke Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity*, and recommends approval of the Application.

3. For these reasons, the Commission finds that Tidewater has met all requirements for the granting of a CPCN and, therefore, the Commission shall approve the Application as filed in PSC Docket No. 08-CPCN-11 on May 28, 2008.

Now, therefore, **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That, pursuant to 26 Del. C. § 203C(e), to the extent it is consistent with this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is granted to Tidewater Utilities, Inc., to serve the areas more specifically identified by the Sussex County Tax Map Parcel Numbers shown in Exhibit "A" of this Order.

2. That Tidewater Utilities, Inc., shall comply with any and all federal, state, county, and local statutes, ordinances, orders, regulations, rules, and permit conditions that are applicable, or may become applicable, to any matter involving water utility services

provided to the service territory granted by this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

3. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
