**ORDER NO. 7480**

**AND NOW**, to-wit, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2008;

**WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2008, Trinsic Communications, Inc. ("Trinsic") filed an application seeking authority to abandon both competitive intrastate and local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Delaware; and

**WHEREAS**, Trinsic was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") pursuant to Rule 7 of the PSC "Rules for the Provision of Telecommunications Services," to provide competitive intrastate telecommunications services by PSC Order No. 4956 (Dec. 1, 1998) in PSC Docket No. 98-340 under the name of Z-Tel Communications, Inc. In Findings and Order No. 5641 (Jan. 30, 2001) in PSC Docket No. 00-576, Trinsic was granted a CPCN to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Delaware under the name of Z-Tel Communications, Inc. In PSC Docket No. 04-473, Z-Tel Communications, Inc. changed its name to Trinsic Communications, Inc., effective January 1, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, 26 Del. C. § 203A(c)(1) provides that no public utility shall abandon or discontinue, in whole or in part, any business, operations, or services provided under a CPCN or otherwise, which are

subject to jurisdiction of the Commission without first having received Commission approval for such abandonment or discontinuance; and

**WHEREAS**, Trinsic filed with the Commission a verified application seeking the entry of an Order of the Commission canceling and terminating its CPCN to provide both competitive intrastate and local exchange telecommunications services; and

**WHEREAS**, Trinsic has asserted that it has no competitive intrastate or local exchange customers in Delaware and no outstanding liabilities to any Delaware customers in the form of deposits nor prepayments for any of its services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has determined that applications to terminate CPCNs granted to provide both competitive intrastate and local exchange telecommunications services should be routinely approved upon the filing of a verified application and that, in a competitive market, such abandonment or discontinuance is presumptively reasonable, necessary, and not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity; now, therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That, upon the express condition that the representations in the verified application of Trinsic Communications, Inc. are true and correct, said application to abandon the provision of competitive intrastate and local exchange telecommunications services as a public utility filed by Trinsic Communications, Inc. is hereby granted and approved effective with the date of this Order.

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
