ORDER NO. 7676

ELECTRIC SUPPLIER CERTIFICATE

This 20th day of October, 2009, the Commission determines and orders the following:

1. On October 8, 2009, TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy ("Tradition Energy" or "Company"), filed an application seeking certification as a retail electric supplier in order to broker the sale or purchase of electric supply service (the "Application"). See 26 Del. C. §§ 1001(2), 1001(11), 1012(a). Under the Electric Utilities Restructuring Act of 1999 (the "Act"),¹ "electric suppliers", which includes brokers, are not "public utilities," and, accordingly, the resulting sales of electric supply service to retail customers are not subject to traditional forms of rate-regulation. See 26 Del. C. §§ 102(2), 202(f).²

2. In the Application, the Company reports that it is a broker that will utilize appropriate energy procurement strategies to meet

² Under the Act, a "broker" is an agent or intermediary in the sale or purchase of electricity to, or by, retail electric customers. Although a broker never takes "title" to the electric supply product, the Act deems a broker an "electric supplier." See 26 Del. C. §§ 1001(2), 1001(11)c.

the needs of its commercial, institutional and industrial customers in Delaware. Staff reports that the Company's application fulfills all the requirements for an Electric Supplier Certificate to act as a broker as set forth in the Commission's Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers (the "ES Rules"). In particular, Staff reports that the Company appears to possess the financial, operational, managerial, and technical capabilities to operate as a broker of electric supply service. Based on Staff's report, the Commission here issues to Tradition Energy an Electric Supplier Certificate, allowing it to broker sales and customer purchases of electric supply services in the State of Delaware consistent with the scheme adopted by the Act and the ES Rules.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF
NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. That TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy, is hereby granted under 26 Del. C. § 1012(a) and the Commission's "Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers" a certificate to do business, and operate, as an "Electric Supplier" (broker) within the State of Delaware. Under this Certificate, TFS Energy Solutions, LLC d/b/a Tradition Energy, is authorized to broker Electric Supply Service within this State in accordance with 26 Del. C. ch. 10.

2. That TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy, shall at all times provide its brokerage of Electric Supply Service in accordance with the requirements imposed by 26 Del. C. ch. 10 and the Commission's "Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers" as presently adopted, or as may be hereafter amended or

supplemented. TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy, is hereby notified that a violation of any applicable statute, rule or other controlling authority may be enforced by the sanctions permitted by 26 Del. C. § 1012(a) and § 10.2 of the "Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers".

3. That TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy, shall, pursuant to the provisions of 26 Del. C. § 1012(c)(2) and §§ 3.9 and 3.10 of the "Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers," file such reports and pay such fees and assessments as may be required, or may be imposed, by 26 Del. C. §§ 114 and 115.

4. That TFS Energy Solutions, LLC, d/b/a Tradition Energy, consents to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Delaware for all acts or omissions related to its offering of electric supply services in this State.

5. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
