ORDER NO. 8067

AND NOW, this 28th day of October, 2011:

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2011, Tidewater Utilities, Inc. ("Tidewater" or "Applicant") filed an application ("Application") with the Delaware Public Service Commission (the "Commission") seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to expand its facilities and operations in order to provide water services to one parcel of land west of Georgetown, three parcels of land northwest of Millsboro, and one parcel of land southwest of Millsboro, Sussex County, Delaware ("Proposed Service Area"). The basis for the Application is Tidewater's possession of petitions requesting water services signed by all of the landowners of record of each parcel or property to be encompassed within the Proposed Service Area in accordance with 26 *Del. C.* §203C(e)(1)b. With its Application, Tidewater filed evidence that it had mailed to the record landowners in the Proposed Service Area notice of its Application and the options available to the affected landowners. In addition, on Staff's direction, Tidewater published notice of its Application in two newspapers of general circulation. No comments regarding the Applicant or this Application have been received; and

WHEREAS, the Commission Staff has completed its review and investigation of the Application and the Applicant, and, in an October 18, 2011, Memorandum to the Commission, reports that Tidewater's Application meets all requirements for the granting of a CPCN under 26 Del. C. §203C and the Commission's *Regulations Governing Water Utilities Including the Public Service Commission's Jurisdiction to Grant and Revoke Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity*, 26 Del. Admin. C. §2002., Thus, the Commission Staff recommends approval of the Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE

VOTE OF NO FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:

1. That, pursuant to 26 Del. C. §203C(e), to the extent it is consistent with this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is granted to Tidewater Utilities, Inc. to serve the area more specifically identified by Kent County Tax Map Parcel Numbers 133-6.00-6.00, 231-14.00-4.02, 333-3.00-18.00, 133-10.00-24.01, 133-11.00-5.00, 133-11.00-6.00, and 133-11.00-7.00.

2. That Tidewater Utilities, Inc. shall comply with any and all federal, state, county, and local statutes, ordinances, orders, regulations, rules, and permit conditions that are applicable, or may become applicable, to any matter involving water utility services provided to the service territory granted by this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

3. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
