In connection with Staff's proposal to use a portion of the MFN financial benefit funds for public interest projects, as stated in their pre-hearing submission filed September 12, 2016, the Joint Applicants generally support Staff's proposal to fund public interest projects and respectfully submit that funding such projects or programs would be consistent with the public interest.


We noted in Staff's recent submission that one alternative variation on Staff's proposal would involve Delmarva Power reviewing proposals or determining the recipients of public interest funding. While Delmarva Power would of course assist with the administration or operation of whatever program is ordered by the Commission, the Joint Applicants' preference is that Delmarva Power not be charged with evaluating programs or making awards for specific projects. Delmarva Power and its employees currently support a number of programs and activities in the communities they serve and to have Delmarva Power undertake such a role might create an impression that Delmarva Power unduly favors certain programs over others or is otherwise vested in specific public interest allocations. To avoid even an appearance of bias or influence, Delmarva Power would prefer to have no decision-making role in the allocation or award process, should the Commission determine to allocate funding to public interest projects.
