**Safety-Valve Relief Application**

**Executive Overview**

Verizon Delaware LLC ("Verizon DE") has an urgent need for 3,000 consecutive numbers for a large business customer, XXXXX. Per the attached customer letter, XXXXX is requesting new numbers for expansion.

Verizon DE is unable to fulfill XXXXX's numbering requirements with current inventory. The resources reside in the WLMGDEWLDS0 switch in the Wilmington Rate Center. The Rate Center has approximately 179,327 available numbers distributed over 602 contaminated 1,000-blocks.

Verizon DE has applied to Neustar for the requested numbers in the WLMGDEWLDS0 switch and was denied because it does not meet the MTE and/or Utilization requirements for this rate center. (see attached). Accordingly, under 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(4), Verizon DE asks that the Commission grant its waiver request and direct Neustar to issue Verizon DE the 3,000 consecutive numbers.

DE PSC Docket Number 16-XXX- Wilmington Safety Valve Request

- 1. A compelling and permissible need for the requested additional numbering resources (with appropriate reference to rules or orders of the FCC).**

Verizon Delaware LLC ("Verizon DE") has an urgent need for 3,000 numbers for one of its customers, XXXXX. Per the attached customer letters, XXXXX is expanding its business and requires 3,000 consecutive numbers in Wilmington. Verizon does not have current inventory to satisfy this customer's requirements.

According to the Third Report and Order and Second Order on Recon. in CC Dkt. No. 96-98 and CC Dkt. No. 99-200, at ¶¶ 61-64, 17 FCC Rcd. 252 (2001) (the "Third Order"), a state commission may grant a carrier's safety valve request when the carrier receives a specific customer request for numbering resources that exceeds the carrier's available inventory.

- 2. A description as to why the granting of the particular application will not run the risk that numbering resources will be inefficiently used.**

Verizon will use the additional numbering resources for only this specific customer, XXXXX, and agrees to return the numbering resources to NeuStar if the customer request is withdrawn or declined. Verizon further agrees that it will not retain the numbering resources to serve other customers without first meeting the FCC's growth numbering resource requirements per ¶64 of the Third Order.

- 3. Written evidence that the NANPA or PA has rejected the carrier's direct request for the additional number resources.**

The rejection letter from NANPA is attached with this filing.

- 4. Describe any long-term impact to numbering resources for the request is granted.**

This request for 3,000 numbers represents less than 1% of the total numbering resources available in this wire center (607,000). As such, granting this request will not result in any long term impacts to the numbering resources in the State of Delaware.
