# FOR ADMISSION AS AN INTERVENOR

AND NOW, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2012, pursuant to the authority granted to me in PSC Order No. 8174 dated July 3, 2012, this Hearing Examiner having considered the Petition for Leave to Intervene ("the Petition") filed by the Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva") on August 9, 2012, and there being no objection thereto filed by any party of record;

# NOW, THEREFORE,

- 1. The Petition is granted.
- 2. In PSC Order No. 8174, the Commission ordered that the deadline for filing petitions for intervention was August 10, 2012. (See Order,  $\P6.$ )
  - 3. Thus, Delmarva's Petition to Intervene was timely filed.
- 4. In its Petition, Delmarva alleges that, "while its interests are generally aligned with those of Chesapeake, Delmarva's interests are separate and potentially different from Chesapeake's" and that Delmarva's "interests will not be adequately represented by

the parties to this proceeding." (See Delmarva's Petition to Intervene

at ¶¶3,4.) Additionally, Delmarva alleges that it "is considering

Tariff changes to make it more economically feasible to extend natural

gas service to residential customers ...." (Id.)

5. No party has opposed Delmarva's Petition.

6. For purposes of considering the merits of Delmarva's

Petition, I assume as true the representations made in Delmarva's

Petition. Specifically, Delmarva has adequately alleged that it has

particularized expertise and experience which may be valuable to the

Commission in deciding the issues in this docket. Thus, Delmarva has

satisfied the intervention requirements of Rule 21 of the Commission's

Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Now, therefore, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Accordingly, the Petition for Intervention filed by the

Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva") is GRANTED.

2. Delmarva shall be added to the Service List for this

Docket, as described in its Petition to Intervene.
