ORDER NO. 7738

GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC WATER UTILITY SERVICES

This $2^{\rm nd}$ day of March, 2010, the Commission finds, determines, and Orders the following:

1. On November 9, 2009, United Water Delaware, Inc. ("United" or "Applicant") filed an application ("Application") with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to expand its facilities and operations in order to provide water services to five parcels of land in the Deerborne Woods and Deerborne Woods II subdivisions located in Newark, New Castle County, Delaware ("Proposed Service Area"). The basis for the Application is United's possession of petitions requesting water services signed by all of the owners of the parcels of land comprising the Proposed Service Area in accordance with 26 Del. C. §203C(e)(1)b. With its Application, United filed evidence that it had mailed to the landowners in the Proposed Service Area notice of its application and the options available to the affected landowners. In addition, on Staff's direction, United published notice of its Application in two

newspapers of general circulation. No comments regarding the Applicant or this Application have been received.

- 2. The Commission Staff has completed its review and investigation of the Application and the Applicant. In a February 12, 2010 Memorandum to the Commission, Staff reports that United's Application meets all requirements for the granting of a CPCN under 26 Del. C. §203C and the Commission's Regulations Governing Water Utilities Including the Public Service Commission's Jurisdiction to Grant and Revoke Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity, and recommends approval of the Application.
- 3. For these reasons, the Commission finds that United has met all requirements for the granting of a CPCN and, therefore, the Commission shall approve the Application in PSC Docket No. 09-CPCN-43 as filed on November 9, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:

- 1. That, pursuant to 26 Del. C. § 203C(e), to the extent it is consistent with this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is granted to United Water Delaware, Inc. to serve the area more specifically identified by the New Castle County Tax Map Parcel Numbers 11-016.30-038, 11-016.40-149, 11-016.40-148, 11-016.40-147, and 11-016.40-146.
- 2. That United Water Delaware, Inc., shall comply with any and all federal, state, county, and local statutes, ordinances, orders, regulations, rules, and permit conditions that are applicable, or may become applicable, to any matter involving water utility services

provided to the service territory granted by this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

3. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
