**ORDER NO. 7793**

**AND NOW**, this 15<sup>TH</sup> day of June, 2010:

**WHEREAS**, on March 15, 2010, a formal Complaint was filed by Mr. Frank Czerwinsky against Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva"), alleging that he was improperly billed for excess electric charges incurred during the month of March 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 29, 2010, Delmarva filed an answer to the Complaint, denying all allegations set forth in the complaint.

**WHEREAS**, because of the disputed factual issues involved, the Commission deems it appropriate to refer the matter to a hearing examiner to conduct an evidentiary hearing.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF  
NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. That Mark Lawrence is designated as the Hearing Examiner for this docket pursuant to 26 Del. C. §502 and 29 Del. C. ch. 101. Hearing Examiner Lawrence shall schedule and conduct such public evidentiary hearings as may be necessary or appropriate to develop a full and complete record concerning this matter. Hearing Examiner Lawrence shall thereafter report to the Commission his proposed findings and recommendations based on the evidence presented.

Pursuant to Rule 21 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, Hearing Examiner Lawrence is delegated the authority to grant or deny petitions to intervene. In addition, Hearing Examiner Lawrence is delegated the authority under 26 Del. C. §102A to determine the content, form, and manner of any further notice in this matter and to grant applications of counsel for admission *pro hac vice*.

2. That Delmarva Power & Light Company is hereby notified that it will be assessed the costs of this proceeding pursuant to 26 Del. C. §114(b).

3. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
