AND NOW, to-wit, this 15th day of May, 2012;

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2012, Yak Communications (America) Inc. ("Yak") filed a verified application seeking the authority to abandon service within the State of Delaware ("Application"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 26 Del. C. §§203A and 703(3), Yak was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide interexchange intrastate telecommunications services by Order No. 6207 (July 8, 2003) in PSC Docket No. 03-31; and

WHEREAS, 26 Del. C. §203A(c)(1) provides that no public utility shall abandon or discontinue, in whole or in part, any regulated public utility business, operations, or services provided under a CPCN or otherwise, which are subject to jurisdiction of the Commission without first having received Commission approval for such abandonment or discontinuance; and

WHEREAS, the Application seeks the entry of an Order of the Commission canceling and terminating its CPCN; and

WHEREAS, Yak has asserted that it has no customers in Delaware and no outstanding liabilities to any Delaware customers in the form of deposits or prepayments for any of its services; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that applications to terminate CPCNs granted to provide interexchange intrastate telecommunications services should be routinely approved upon the filing of a verified application and that, in a competitive market, such abandonment or discontinuance is presumptively reasonable, necessary, and not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE
AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. That, upon express condition that the representations in the verified application of Yak Communications (America) Inc. are true and correct, said application to abandon the provision of interexchange intrastate telecommunications services as a public utility filed by Yak Communications (America) Inc. is hereby granted and approved effective with the date of this Order.

2. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
