**PUBLIC NOTICE**

On December 7, 2017 at 1:00 pm, the Delaware Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of proposed regulations for the limited purpose of complying with the Memorandum Opinion, issued December 30, 2016, in **Delaware Division of the Public Advocate v. Delaware Public Service Commission**, C.A. N15A-12-002 AML, which requires the Commission to revise its regulations as needed to specify the procedures for freezing the minimum cumulative solar photovoltaic and eligible energy resource requirements under 26 **Del. C.** §§354(i) and (j). The hearing will be held in accordance with 26 **Del. C.** §362(b) and 29 **Del. C.** §10117 during the regularly scheduled Commission meeting at the following time and location:

The Commission will render a decision, either to adopt and re-publish its proposed regulations as final, or to amend and issue new proposed regulations in this matter based upon the hearing. In Order No. 9090, the Commission ordered the republishing of its proposed regulations on September 1, 2017 and set a second public comment period which ended October 2, 2017.
