**ORDER NO. 9184**

**AND NOW**, this 1st day of February 2018, the Delaware Public Service Commission ("Commission") determines and orders the following:

**WHEREAS**, on August 18, 2017, pursuant to 29 *Del. C.* §8059(h), Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva") filed an application (the "Application") with the Commission requesting approval of (1) its proposed energy efficiency programs, which consist of a Consumer Products Program and a Behavior Based Program and (2) its proposed rate recovery mechanism (together, the "2017 EE Program"); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 14, 2017 in Commission Order No. 9112, Pursuant to 26 *Del. Admin. C.* §§1001-2.1.1 and 2.9.3, the Commission designated Hearing Examiner R. Campbell Hay and gave him the authority to grant or deny petitions seeking leave to intervene, to grant or deny motions for admission of counsel *pro hac vice* and to set an appropriate procedural schedule. Pursuant to 26 *Del. Admin. C.* §1001-2.11 and consistent with Delmarva's request to expedite this proceeding, Hearing Examiner Hay was granted the authority to schedule and conduct the evidentiary hearing en banc at a scheduled Commission meeting; and

**WHEREAS,** Hearing Examiner Hay has recently resigned from his position with the Commission and will not be available to conclude the assignment designated in Order 9112.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE**

**VOTE OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. That Mark Lawrence is designated as Hearing Examiner for this matter pursuant to the terms of 26 *Del. C.* §502 and 29 *Del. C.* ch. 101 to continue the assigned responsibilities in this docket, as may be necessary. Pursuant to 26 *Del. Admin. C.* §1001-2.11 and consistent with Delmarva's request to expedite this proceeding, Senior Hearing Examiner Lawrence is granted the authority to schedule and conduct the evidentiary hearing en banc at a scheduled Commission meeting.

2. The Commission Secretary shall promptly serve a copy of this Order on the Division of the Public Advocate.

3. The Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.
