PUBLIC NOTICE OF FILING and EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

**TO: ALL ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS OF DELMARVA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY AND
OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS**

On August 18, 2017, Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Delmarva") filed an application ("Application") with the Delaware Public Service Commission ("Commission"). The Application requested Commission approval of Energy Efficiency Programs and a Rate Recovery mechanism (together the "2017 EE Program") recommended by the Energy Efficiency Advisory Council, of which Delmarva is a member.

In its request, Delmarva seeks Commission approval of two (2) programs: a Consumer Products Program and a Behavior Based Program. The Consumer Products Program will offer energy efficient lighting, appliance rebates and appliance recycling. The Behavioral Based Program will motivate customers to engage in energy savings behavior through regular distribution of personalized home energy reports.

Delmarva estimates that the total cost of the 2017 EE Program will be \$17,606,956 over three years, with estimated gross benefits of \$31 million. Delmarva projects the bill impact on a typical residential customer as follows:

The Commission will make its decision on this matter on the basis of the evidence of record taken at a public evidentiary hearing to be held at a regularly-scheduled meeting on May 8, 2018 at the Commission's office located at 861 Silver Lake Boulevard, Cannon Building, Suite 100, Dover, Delaware 19904.
