The Delaware Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) issued Orders Nos. 9220 and 9397 that required a separate docket be opened to address whether third party electric supplier consolidated billing (“SCB”) should be permitted and adopted in Delaware.

Commission Staff (“Staff”) submitted a petition to open a docket to examine whether third party electric SCB should be permitted and adopted in Delaware. The petition has been docketed as 19-0333.

Commission Staff is requesting SCB proposals and comments from electric distribution companies, third party electric suppliers, statutory advocates, and interested parties.

All parties and interested persons may file proposals or written comments *on or before December 31, 2019*. If you wish to formally participate as a party in this matter, you must file with the Commission a written petition asking for leave to intervene in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (26 *Del. Admin. C.* § 1001-2.9) *on or before November 29, 2019*. All written proposals, comments, or petitions for leave to intervene should be sent to the Commission's address:
