- A. The Applicant is in possession of a signed service agreement with the developer of a proposed subdivision or development, which subdivision or development has been duly approved by the respective county government. (26 Del. C. § 203C (e) (1) (b) (1)).
- B. The Applicant has one or more petitions requesting water service from the applicant executed by the landowners of record of each parcel or property to be encompassed within the proposed territory to be served. (26 Del. C. § 203C (e) (1) (b) (2)).
- C. - A. Complete details of the Company are on file with the Commission, including information on the Company's financial and operational capabilities.
- B. AWC has been in the business of providing a safe, secure, reliable water supply to customers for over 100 years.
- C. AWC is an affiliate of Artesian Resources Corporation ("ARC"). Information detailing the organizational structure of ARC and its affiliates is on file with the Commission.
- D. AWC currently serves approximately 95,241 customers throughout the State of Delaware.
- E. AWC facilities are operated by fully licensed operators that have operated in full compliance with applicable federal and state rules, regulations, and laws.
- F. AWC provides a minimum threshold for water pressure of at least 25 psi to all existing customers. AWC states that it will provide service to the parcel that meet or exceed water pressure guidelines.
- G. AWC provides superior service and is not subject to any orders from the Commission finding the Company has materially failed to provide adequate or proper safe water services to existing customers.
- H. AWC is not subject to a ruling or decision from DNREC or any other regulatory authority finding that the Company has materially failed to provide adequate or proper safe water services to existing customers.

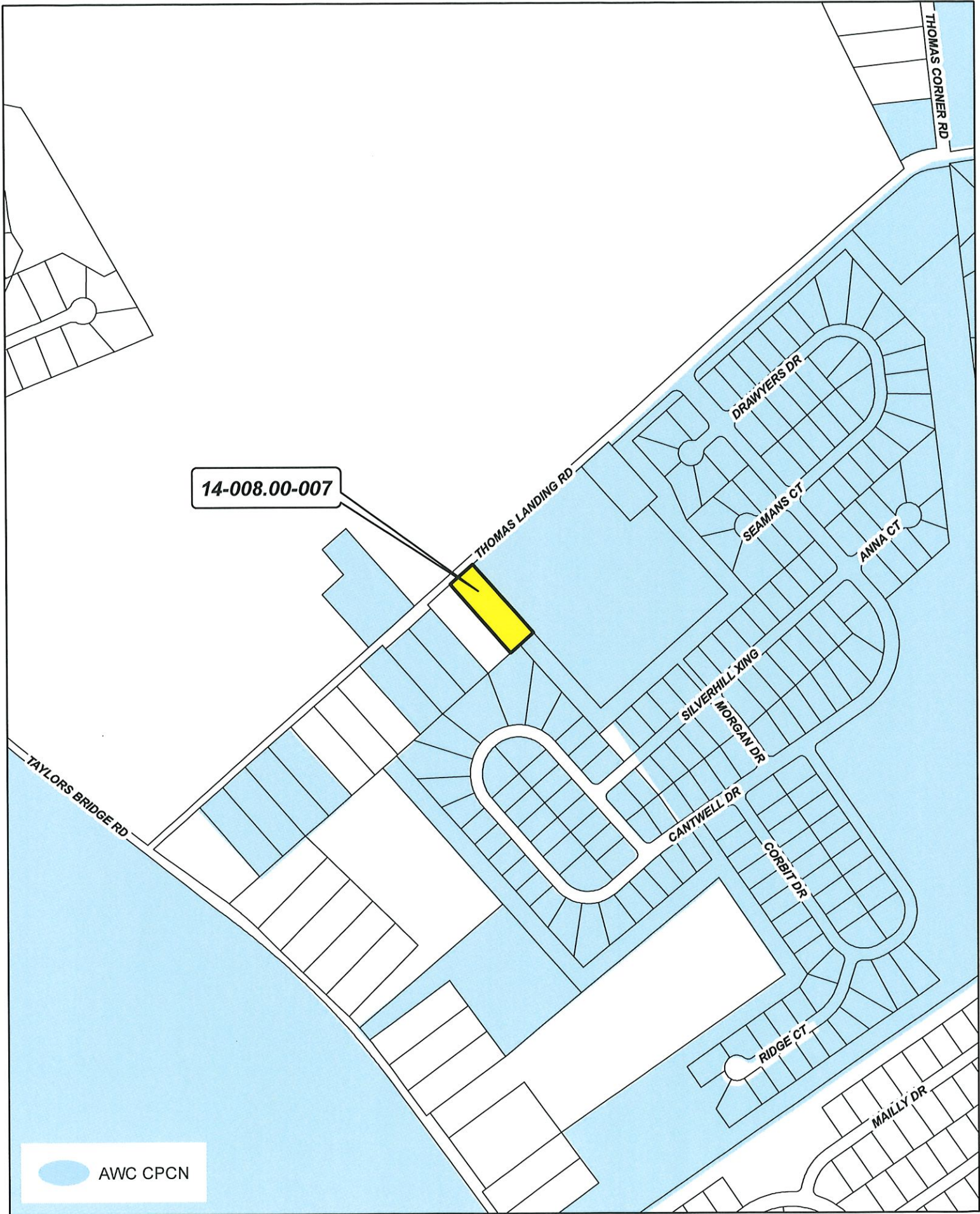

Within thirty-five (35) days, Artesian Water Company, Inc. plans to file an application with the Delaware Public Service Commission requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (Certificate) to provide water service to a new territory described as THOMASLANDING007.

ARTESIAN WATER COMPANY, INC. HAS INCLUDED YOUR PROPERTY IN THE TERRITORY IT INTENDS TO SERVE. ARTESIAN WATER COMPANY, INC. IS ABLE TO PROVIDE WATER SERVICE TO YOUR PROPERTY THROUGH AN EXISTING WATER MAIN LOCATED ON THOMAS LANDING ROAD. ARTESIAN WATER COMPANY, INC. IS ABLE TO PROVIDE WATER SERVICE TO THOMASLANDING007 WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.

IF YOU DO NOT TAKE ANY ACTION NOW, YOU MAY LOSE YOUR CHOICE OF WHO CAN PROVIDE WATER SERVICE TO YOUR PROPERTY AND WHETHER YOU CAN OBTAIN A WELL PERMIT.

- 1) **You may choose to be included in the utility's proposed service territory. If you signed a petition for water service asking to be included in the utility's proposed service territory, or, if you did not sign a petition for water service but want to be included, you do not have to take any action.**
- 2) You have the right to "opt-out" of the utility's proposed service territory. If you "opt-out", your property will not be included in the utility's service territory. You can do this even though others might desire water service from the utility. **You should understand that being included in a utility's service territory does not mean that public water service will be immediately available to your property or that, when available, you will be required to hook-up to the public water system.** However, if your property is included in the utility's water service territory, and later the water from the well providing your drinking water cannot be used, the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control might deny you a permit for a new well if public water is available to your property. On the other hand, if you elect to "opt-out" of the utility's service territory, but later change your mind and decide to connect to the utility's public water system, you could be charged additional fees.
- 3) You may object to the Public Service Commission granting a Certificate for THOMASLANDING007. For example, you may object that the water utility does not have the legal right to serve the territory. You should review the law about what a utility must provide in order to obtain a Certificate (contact the Public Service Commission to obtain a copy of the law). If you file such an objection, you will need to tell the Public Service Commission why the utility should not receive the Certificate. 



Thank you for your email dated May 26, 2023, regarding Artesian Water Company, Inc. ("Artesian") providing temporary emergency water service at 172 Thomas Landing Road, Middletown, DE 19709. I understand the application is the result of a letter from Jacques Janvier and Stanley Volne ("Property Owners") requesting that Artesian be allowed to provide temporary emergency water service to the property prior to receiving a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") from the Public Service Commission ("Commission"); the Property Owners letter indicates that the well serving the property has failed. I understand that, while subject property is not currently in a CPCN area, Artesian is in the process of completing the work needed to submit an application for a CPCN for this property.

Because the Property Owners are in immediate need of water service, Artesian has sought permission to serve this property prior to the Commission's approval of a CPCN. Commission Staff has reviewed the request, and given the information, and the fact that the completed application and full review cannot be completed in time to meet the needs of the customer, the Commission Staff will not seek any sanctions against Artesian for providing temporary water services to this specific property without an approved CPCN. This Commission Staff action is with the understanding that, should the Commission deny the requested CPCN, Artesian must immediately discontinue all water services to that property.
