On July 17, 2024, Delmarva Power & Light Company filed an application with the Commission seeking approval to establish an alternative form of rate regulation known as a Performance-Based Plan. A Performance-Based Plan bases rate recovery on future forecasted test periods, paired with customer protections known as Earning Sharing Mechanisms. Such a plan often includes Performance Incentive Mechanisms. A Performance-Based Plan is distinct from a traditional ratemaking process that is based on recovering a rate of return. Delmarva Power does not seek any rate changes in this application.

On October 29, 2024, the Company filed a supplemental application with supporting

testimony that is meant to address statutory elements found in 26 *Del. C.* § 201(e).

The Commission will make its decision on this matter on the basis of the record evidence taken at the public evidentiary hearings, which will be conducted at a later date. The Commission may approve or reject, in whole or in part, Delmarva Power's application.
