An evidentiary hearing on this application will not be held unless there is a meritorious request received within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice. Pursuant to current law, property owners within the proposed CPCN service area may file an objection to the issuance of a CPCN to AWC and may also choose to "opt-out" of inclusion in the proposed service area.
