On September 20, 2024, Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Delmarva”) filed with the Commission an application (“Application”) seeking approval of: (1) a revenue requirement increase of \$42 million; and (2) changes to its natural gas service tariff as described in the Application.

Since filing its Application, Delmarva has adjusted its revenue requirement request to seek an

increase of \$45.4 million.

On July 8, 2025, a Commission hearing examiner conducted an in-person and virtual public comment session for the purpose of taking public comment regarding the Application.

An evidentiary hearing regarding Delmarva's Application is scheduled to be held November 10, 2025, November 12, 2025, November 13, 2025, November 14, 2025, and November 17, 2025. Please note that no session will occur on November 11, 2025, because it is a State holiday in observance of Veterans Day. Each party to this proceeding will have the right to present evidence including through witness testimony. This hearing will be open to the public but only parties and the sole intervenor in the docket will be entitled to be heard.

After the hearing, the Parties will present written arguments to the Hearing Examiner who will then issue a recommendation to the Commission. The Commission will thereafter make its decision on this matter on the basis of the record evidence taken at that hearing. The Commission may approve or reject, in whole or in part, and Hearing Examiner recommendation, and may approve a different method for allocating any increase that it may grant.
