On October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the Commission signed Order number 10829 formally opening a docket to establish a large load tariff and ordered Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Delmarva”) to develop and file proposed revised tariff pages applicable to large load customers defined as customers that will use a monthly maximum demand of 25 MW or greater. On December 19, 2025, Delmarva filed a proposed tariff. The Commission designated Hearing

Examiner Lawrence to schedule public comment sessions, workshops, and evidentiary hearings as may be necessary to have a full and complete record concerning the justness and reasonableness of the proposed tariff modification. Thereafter, Hearing Examiner Lawrence will file with the Commission for its consideration his proposed order with his findings and recommendations. The Commission will make its decision on this matter on the basis of the record evidence taken at the public evidentiary hearings. The Commission may approve or reject, in whole or in part, the proposed tariff.
