**PUBLIC NOTICE OF CHANGES TO  
THE RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARDS RATE FACTORS**

**TO: ALL ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS OF DELMARVA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY**

On March 27, 2026, Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Delmarva” or the “Company”) filed with the Delaware Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an application to make changes to its Electric Tariff related to its Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards compliance charge (“RPS Charge”) for all service classifications.

According to the Company’s calculations, the RPS Charge will be \$0.005172/kWh, or a decrease of 11%.

On April 22, 2026, in PSC Order No. 11000, the Commission allowed the proposed rates and tariff changes to go into effect, with usage on or after June 1, 2026, on a temporary basis, but subject to refund with interest if the Commission later determines in a final order that such rates and charges are incorrect, unjust, or unreasonable or otherwise violate Delaware law.

If you wish to file written comments or objections to the proposed changes *you must do so on or before July 27, 2026*. If you want to formally participate as a party in this matter, with the right to present evidence and be represented by counsel, you must file with the Commission a

written petition asking for leave to intervene in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (26 Del. Admin. C. § 1001-2.9) **on or before July 27, 2026**. All written comments, objections, or petitions for leave to intervene should be filed using DelaFile (<http://delafile.delaware.gov>) or be sent to the Commission's address:
