On April 4, 2025, Artesian Water Company, Inc. (“Artesian”) filed an application (the “Application”) with the Commission seeking approval for an increase in its water base rates and certain changes to its water tariff.

In its Application, Artesian seeks an increase in annual operating revenues of \$10,849,935, or an increase of 12.41% over existing base rates.

An evidentiary hearing regarding the Application is scheduled to begin June 29, 2026. Each Party to this proceeding will have the right to present evidence including through witness testimony. This hearing will be open to the public, but only the Parties and the sole intervenor in the docket will be entitled to be heard.

After the hearing, the Parties will present written arguments to the Hearing Examiner who will then issue a recommendation to the Commission. The Commission will thereafter make its decision on this matter on the basis of the record evidence taken at the hearing. The Commission may approve or reject, in whole or in part, the Hearing Examiner's recommendation, and may approve a different method for allocating any increase that it may grant.
