On May 12, 2026, Delmarva Power & Light Company, (the “DPL”) and Delaware Electric Cooperative, Inc. (“DEC”) (collectively the “Joint Applicants”) notified the Delaware Public Service Commission (“Commission”) of their intent to adjust their shared retail electric service territory boundary with respect to approximately 234.761 acres of land in Sussex County, Delaware. The property is part of an approved residential community known as Azalea Woods (“Azalea Woods”), which lies within the retail electric service territories of both DEC and

Delmarva Power. The property is owned by Azalea Woods, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, and the retail electric service territory being transferred consists of Sussex County Tax Parcel No. 135-11.00-49.00 and a part of Sussex County Tax Parcel No. 135-11.00- 49.03.

A public hearing regarding the Joint Application is scheduled to be held June 24, 2026.
