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On June 22, 2026 Tidewater Utilities, Inc., filed an application with the Delaware Public Service Commission ("PSC") for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide water services to the following parcels: (1) 231-7.00-32.01 - is a parcel located on the west side of Royetta Ln. and is located about 1,105 feet from the intersection of Royetta Ln. and Seashore Hwy. (2) 231-11.00-13.02 is a parcel located on the south side of Racoon Ditch Rd. and is located about 745 feet from the intersection of Racoon Ditch Rd. and Hudson Ln. (3) 231-12.00-382.00 - is a parcel located on the south side of Deep Creek Dr. and is located about 285 feet from the intersection of Deep Creek Dr. and River end Dr. (4) 231-17.00-37.04 – is a parcel located on the west side of Fleetwood Pond Rd. and is located about 150 feet from the intersection of Fleetwood Pond Rd. and Baker Mill Rd. (5) 232-19.00-81.00 – is a parcel located on the south side of Shiloh Way and is located about 785 feet from the intersection of Shiloh Way and Hitch Pond Rd. The basis for the application is Tidewater Utilities, Inc. possession of a petition requesting water services signed by all of the landowners in the proposed service area as set forth in 26 Del. C. §203C(e)(1)b.

The PSC is investigating this matter to the extent deemed necessary to determine whether the CPCN should be granted. An evidentiary hearing on this application will not be held unless there is a meritorious request received within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice. A meritorious request is deemed to be one which sets forth reasonable grounds why a public hearing would be appropriate or would be in the public interest.

Pursuant to current law, property owners within the proposed CPCN service area may file an objection to the issuance of a CPCN to Tidewater Utilities, Inc. and may also choose to “opt-out” of inclusion in the proposed service area. Written notice of such objection or a decision to “opt-out” of inclusion in the proposed service area must be sent to the Delaware Public Service Commission at the following address within thirty (30) days after publication of this notice.
